### USES

- ☒ For best results and prolonged life we recommend hand washing using a non-abrasive pad. If using a dishwasher, please follow manufacturer's instructions.
- ☒ Glass tableware is suitable for use in chilled and ambient temperatures.
- ☒ Glass tableware is suitable for hot and cold food use
- ☒ Wash glass tableware as soon after use as possible after use.
- ☒ Use a plastic spatula to remove leftovers as metal may mark or scratch the piece.
- ☒ Wash before first use.

### MISUSES

- ☒ Immediately remove chipped or damaged glass tableware from use.
- ☒ Not suitable for oven use.
- ☒ Do not expose glass tableware to direct flames or excessive heat, including heat lamps.
- ☒ Avoid the use of harsh chemicals and the use of harsh or abrasive scouring products.
- ☒ If using a dishwasher, space the items properly and do not overfill.
- ☒ If using a dishwasher, keep china, glass and metal items separate. This will reduce the possibility of chipping, breakage and marking.
- ☒ Allow items to air-dry before stacking.
- ☒ Do not over-stack
